## **Kincare Coalition 2023 Proposed Policy Agenda Overview**

#### YOU CAN HELP!

- 3. Use the talking points below to start the conversation:

#### **Maintain Funding**

The Coalition requests flat funding in the NYS Budget of \$2,550,250 for the Kinship System of Care.

- \$320,500 for the Kinship Navigator (\$220,500 + \$100,000)
- \$2,238,750 for local programs (\$338,750 + \$1.9 million or \$950,000 from each house)

### **Kinship Care Month**

Since 2014, New York State has marked September as Kinship Care Month. We request the same designation in 2023 to honor those who are working to raise stronger kids and build a better future for New York's families.

#### **Kinship Legal Network**

Indigent kinship caregivers do not have a guaranteed right to counsel when they seek custody or guardianship in family court. Some judges assign counsel, but many do not. We're advocating for \$8 million in funding for the Office of Children and Family Services to provide much-needed legal representation to non-parent caregivers who are navigating the family court and welfare systems

#### **Revise Non-Parent Grant Calculation**

(A. 2488 – Hevesi) We want to address the way TANF income is calculated for a Non-Parent Grant. Unearned income of siblings and caregivers residing in the household is currently included when determining eligibility and amount of assistance. This reduces the grant for the entire household, and results in fewer resources for the child in need.
